Object Pronouns

ἢ - Third Conjugation

ΝΗΙ	- me
ΝΔΚ	- you (m)
ΝΕ	- you (f)
ΝΔϚ	- him
ΝΔϚ	- her
ΝΔΝ	- us
ΝΩΤΕΝ	- you (pl)
ΝΩΟΥ	- them

ΝΕΜ – with + pronoun

ΝΕΜΗΙ	- with me
ΝΕΜΔΚ	- with you (m)
ΝΕΜΕ	- with you (f)
ΝΕΜΔϚ	- with him
ΝΕΜΔϚ	- with her
ΝΕΜΔΝ	- with us
ΝΕΜΩΤΕΝ	- with you (pl)
ΝΕΜΩΟΥ	- with them

Examples:

ΜΟΙ ΝΗΙ	- give me
ΧΕΡΕ ΝΔΚ	- bless you (masc)
ΧΕΡΕ ΝΕ	- bless you (fem)
ΤΑΞΙΡΗΝΗ †† ἄμωϚ ΝΩΤΕΝ	- my peace I give to you
ΠῚ ΟΙϚ ΝΕΜΔΚ	- the Lord be with you
ΜΩϚ ΝΕΜΔϚ	- go (walk) with him
ΔΜΟΥ ΝΕΜΗΙ	- coem with me

Verb to go

The verb to go is conjugated with prefix (tense) and suffix (person):

ΔΙΨΕΝΗΙ	- I went
ΔΚΨΕΝΔΚ	- you went (m)
ΔΡΕΨΕΝΕ	- you went (f)
ΔϚΨΕΝΔϚ	- he went
ΔϚΨΕΝΔϚ	- she went
ΔΝΨΕΝΔΝ	- we went
ΔΡΕΤΕΝΨΕΝΩΤΕΝ	- you went (pl)
ΔΥΨΕΝΩΟΥ	- they went

Imperative – verb to go

μαῶενᾰκ - Go (masc)
μαῶενε - Go (fem)
μαῶενωτεν - Go (pl)
