Prefix Verbs

I. † & βι as prefixes

<p>†εβω - to teach †ωον - to glorify †χου - to strengthen †κα† - to explain; to clarify</p>		<p>βιεβω - to learn βιωον - to be glorified βιχου - to be strengthened βιμου - to take a blessing</p>
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Verbs with prefix †- change to prefix μα- in the imperative:

<p>μαεβω - teach</p>		<p>μακα† νηι - explain to me</p>
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Also for verbs that begin with letter "τ" add the prefix μα- in the imperative:

<p>ματαιο - to respect ματαμο - to tell</p>		<p>ματαλβο - to heal, to cure μα†ρο - to ask (for)</p>
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II. Prefix ερ- added to a noun makes a verb

<p>ερονωινι - to light ερεμοτ - to give grace ερο† - to fear ερφεγι - to remember ερψαλιν - to sing psalms; to chant ερωμι - to be a human being</p>		<p>ερφαρι - to heal, to cure εροβι - to sin ερονο - to increase ερητс - to begin ερεμπω - to deserve</p>
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Verbs with prefix ερ- change to prefix αρι- in the imperative:

<p>αριονωινι - turn on the light αριεμοτ - give us grace (grant)</p>		<p>αριψαλιν - chant αριφεγι - remember αρονο - increase</p>
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In the verb ἀριθμενὶ the φ is conjugated:

ἀριπαμενὶ	- remember me
ἀριπερμενὶ	- remember him
ἀριπερμενὶ	- remember her
ἀριπενμενὶ	- remember us
ἀριπορμενὶ	- remember them

III. Prefix χεμ- for "find" (abbreviated form)

χεμχου	- to find strength
χεμνου†	- to find comfort
χεμζηου	- to find use (to be useful)

IV. Prefix ωεπ- for "receive"

ωεπέουτ	- to receive grace
ωεπέουτ	- to receive pain
ωεπέουτ	- to tolerate; to resign oneself, to accept

V. Prefix ὤ- for "can"

ὤσασι	- can speak
ὤσι	- can do
