Preposition (of) **ἄτε** , **ἄ** , **ἄ**

Examples:

1. **Πωηρι ἄτε φτ**
The son of God.
2. **Πη ἄτε νιαστειλοσ**
The house of the angels.
3. **Ϝεκκλησια ἄτε τπαρθενος**
The church of the virgin.
4. **Πιωμ ἄτε παιωτ**
The book of my father.
5. **Ϝαχπ ἄτε τακωνι**
The watch of my siter.
6. **Πιχλου ἄτε ἡωνδ**
The crown of the life.
7. **Πιχλου ἄτε τρομπι**
The crown of the year.
8. **Πιωαι ἄτε πιχινωισι** (i.e. Christmas)
The feast of the birth.
9. **Πιωαι ἄτε πιεταυροσ**
The feast of the cross.
10. **Πιωαι ἄτε πιχιντωνοσ**
The feast of the resurrection.
11. **Πιψηληλ ἄτε ταχπ ωουτ**
The prayer of the hour (third).
12. **Πιεεοον ἄτε πενωωνδ.**
The days of our life.
