Possessive Adjective **Πικωστ `ναμονι**

The Possessive Adjectives are **ALWAYS** connected to the noun.

Possessed Noun (Singular masculine)	Possessed Noun (Singular feminine)
Παιωτ <u>my</u> father	Ταματ <u>my</u> mother
Πεκιωτ <u>your</u> father (m.)	Τεκουατ <u>your</u> mother
Πειωτ <u>your</u> father (f.)	Τεματ <u>your</u> mother
Πεφιωτ <u>his</u> father	Τεφματ <u>his</u> mother
Πεσιωτ <u>her</u> father	Τεσιματ <u>her</u> mother
Πενωτ <u>our</u> father (pl.)	Τενωματ <u>our</u> mother
Ποφιωτ <u>their</u> father (pl.)	Τοφιματ <u>their</u> mother

Possessed Noun (Plural m. & f.)

Ναχωμ	:	<u>my</u> books
Νεκχωμ	:	<u>your</u> books (m.)
Νεχωμ	:	<u>your</u> books (f.)
Νεφχωμ	:	<u>his</u> books
Νεσιχωμ	:	<u>her</u> books
Νενωμ	:	<u>our</u> books
Νετενωμ	:	<u>your</u> books (Pl.)
Νοφιχωμ	:	<u>their</u> books
