

Lesson Twenty One Πρωτοῦ Χοροῦ ὄρα

Transitive Verb Form

1. Long Form: used with prefixes on the object.
Example: ἀὶςᾶ ἀπὶ πῶς – I wrote the lesson.
2. Short form: used without prefixes on the object.
Example: ἀὶςᾶ πῶς – I wrote the lesson.
3. Abbreviated form: joins the object pronoun to verb.
Example: ἀὶςᾶ τῆς – I wrote it .
4. Past participle form:
Example: ἐγὼςᾶχοροῦ – written.
