Examples:

- The verses of the cymbals

Ἰενορωψτ ἄΨιωτ νεμ Πῶηρι νεμ Πιπῆᾶ ἔῶῆ: †τρίαρ ἔῶῆ: ἵουοορσιορ.	We worship the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit, the Holy Trinity of one essence.
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Ἰεη : we (subject)
ορωψτ : worship (verb)
ἄ : the sign of the object
Ψιωτ : the father (object)

- The Theotokia of Sunday- Part 7

Ἰεχολρ ἄπιτορβο: ραῶη νεμ ραβολ: ὠ †ρκηνη ἵκαθαρορ: ῥμαῆῶωπι ἵηιδικεορ.	You are veiled with purity, from within and without, O the pure tabernacle: the dwelling of the righteous.
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Ἰεχολρ : you (subject)
χολρ : veiled (verb)
ἄ : sign of the object
πιτορβο : purity (object)

Examples:

1. The Hymn of "The King of the Peace"

Πορο ἦτε τειρηνῆ: μοι νᾶν	O the King of (the) peace, give us
ἦτεκτειρηνῆ: σεμνι νᾶν	Your peace, affirm to us Your
ἦτεκτειρηνῆ: χα νεννοβι νᾶν ἐβολ.	peace, forgive us our sins.

μοι : give (verb, imperative mode)

ἦ : the sign of the object

τειρηνῆ : Your peace (object)

2. The Exposition of Tuesday

Χε ἀρεωπι ἦνοθρονος:	You became a royal throne to
ἠβασιλικον: ἠφνετορτα ἠμοσ:	Him who is carried upon the
ειχεν νιχερονβι.	cherubim.

ἀρε : you (subjec)

ωπι : became (verb, past tense)

ἦ : the sign of the object

οθρονος : a throne (object)

ἐ is used with verbs of the senses and a few others. Examples of these verbs are listed below:

ἀναϑ	to look	ἔβαι	to write	ἀλῆι	to ride
ωλεμ	to smell	μοϑ	to call	ἀρελ	To learn
βοε	to touch	ναεϑ	to believe	ἔμοϑ	to bless
ϑεο	to entreat	ωιϑι ε	to shake hands	ϑιϑι ἠ	to ask
ωτεμ	to listen	ωαρι	to hit	εωε	to praise
χοϑωϑ	to wait				

Examples:

1. The Theotokia of Sunday – Part 18

Δ σνάυ ε πιάστρελος: εφθευσι ζιχεν πιώνι: εφωψ `εβολ εφχω `μμοc: χε αφτωνφ `φχη `μπαι μα αν.	She looked (at) the angel, sitting on the rock crying out (and) saying, 'For He is risen, He is not in this place.'
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Δc : she (subject)

νάυ : looked (verb)

ε : the sign of the object

πιάστρελος : the angel (object)

2. The Doxology of the Morning

Ϝ ωτεμ ε τενcμη: κατα πεκνιω† νηαι: ναζμεν Π οc Π εννο†: κατα νεκμετφενζητ.	Listen to our voices according to Your great mercy (and) save us O Lord our God according to thy tendermercies.
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Ϝωτεμ : hear (verb, imperative mode)

ε : the sign of the object

τενcμη : our voice (object)

3. The Third Canticle

Ϝ μοφ ε Ποc νιφνο†ι ζωc `εροφ αριζονο† β`αcφ ψα νιενεζ.	Bless the Lord O the heavens, praise Him, exalt Him unto the ages.
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Ϝμοφ : bless (verb)

ε : the sign of the object

Ποc : the Lord (object)
